CANCELLATION POLICY FOR SUMMER COOKING CAMP: Payments are non-refundable but camper can transfer to another 2017 summer camp, if a seat is available, if notice is given no later than TWO WEEKS BEFORE the scheduled camp. There is no refund or credit, full or partial, for camper illness or any other reason for non-attendance.

CAMP POLICIES AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Camp Hours: Depending on the program, camp begins as posted, usually 10 a.m. or 2 p.m. each day and runs for 3 hours, except the last day of multi-session camps when class runs 3 ½ to 4 hours. As a courtesy to the other campers and Pans on Fire staff, please observe the schedule. Staff will remain with students only 15 minutes after each session; likewise, students should be dropped off no earlier than 10 minutes prior to camp start time.

May your child leave after camp without an adult in attendance? Indicate YES or NO

Breakfast/Lunch and Meals: Campers will prepare a full meal that should be served about ½ hour before the end of camp each day. We also plan for a mid-class snack. (In baking programs, a savory dish will be prepared.) We recommend each camper have a full breakfast (or lunch for afternoon sessions) prior to camp so they are comfortable waiting to eat.

Guest Meals: ONE adult ticket is provided for lunch on the last day of 4-session and 5-session camps. Please check with the front desk or instructor on Wednesday to determine arrival time (usually 1 pm or 4 pm) for seating. Additional seat tickets are \$15 and must be purchased no later than the day before, subject to availability. One child (age 3 or younger) can sit on the adult's lap without charge.

Allergies and Food Preferences: Pans on Fire does not use peanut oil. If your child has a food allergy, food restriction or food aversion, please be sure to disclose it on the front of this registration form. **We do not guarantee an allergy-free environment but will do what we can to accommodate the camper. In some but not all instances, food substitutions can be made.**

Healthy Camper Policy. For the health of other campers and staff, **please do not send a sick camper to camp.** We will provide the recipes for the day missed and by appointment we will be happy to discuss the missed class cooking techniques. There is no refund or credit for a missed day of camp.

Dress Code: Campers should be dressed for comfort and safety. **No open-toe shoes allowed** (no sandals or flip-flops). **Campers wearing open-toed shoes WILL NOT be permitted to participate in cooking activities.** Clothing should not be too loose. No jewelry please. Long hair needs to be tied back with bands or clips. A chef's coat or apron is provided.

Conduct: For the enjoyment of all participants, each camper is asked to be on his or her best behavior. We are very patient with kids and will make every effort to see that all campers have a positive experience. Cell phones and any other electronic devices must be kept in a packed bag or face temporary confiscation. In the event a camper's behavior becomes disruptive, especially where cooking and food safety are involved, we reserve the right to sit the camper out of the activity and/or ask the camper not to return. In this event, the camper's registration fee is not refundable.

Photographs: On occasion, photos and videos are taken of a class activity. You consent to the use of you and your child's image in commercial promotion of Pans on Fire. You understand that neither you nor your child will receive any compensation for use of such pictures or video.

Pans on Fire Productions, LLC (dba Pans on Fire) is committed to conducting its programs in the safest manner possible and holds the safety of its participants in the highest possible regard. Parents/guardians registering their child/ward in Pans on Fire programs must recognize, however, that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in cooking programs. Pans on Fire continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions which have been designed to protect the participants' safety. Parents/guardians registering their child/ward for the programs should review their own health insurance policy for coverage. It must be noted that the absence of health insurance does not make Pans on Fire nor the program responsible for payment of medical expenses.

Release of Liability and Assumption of Risk Agreement: Participation in this recreational cooking class involves the use of cooking equipment and exposure to potential food allergens, flame and heat in a kitchen environment with other people. CONSUMING RAW OR UNDERCOOKED MEATS, POULTRY, SEAFOOD, SHELLFISH OR EGGS MAY INCREASE THE RISK OF FOODBORNE ILLNESS. The signatory, individually and on behalf of the registered minor camper, hereby waives, releases and discharges any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which you or the minor child may have, or which may hereafter accrue to either of you as a result of participation in this class. This Release Agreement is intended to discharge in advance Pans on Fire Productions, LLC, its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected with participation in said class and entry to and use of any facilities or equipment, even though that liability may arise out of NEGLIGENCE or CARELESSNESS on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above.
